Conditions

The Meet

1. The Meet The promoter is Hatfield Swim Club Ltd.
2. The event is to be held at 'The Hertfordshire Sports Village' Hatfield, Hertfordshire.
3. The competition is to be held under ASA laws and ASA technical rules of swimming.
4. The competition is licensed by the ASA as a **LEVEL 3** meet.
5. Entrants must be ASA Registered at category 2 and have an ASA number and belong to an affiliated club.
6. Qualification times must have been achieved in the twelve months prior to the event, converted to short course.
7. Clubs entering more than 6 swimmers must do so electronically by using Hy-Teks 'Team Manager Lite'.
You can either download it from 'Hy-Teks' website (<http://www.hy-tek ltd.com/downloads.html>) or apply to us for a CD, so you can enter your swimmers information and times into the programme create an entries file and either post (a floppy disc) or e-mail your file to us for inclusion in the meet.
8. If a club enters more than 6 swimmers by means of entry forms rather than an entry file from Team Manager, these entries will be returned.
9. Entries of six or less swimmers will only be accepted on the official entry form along with a completed summary sheet
10. Entries of more than six swimmers must send us your Team Manager entries file along with a completed summary sheet and payment.
11. Entry forms and Team Manager files must be received by the promoters on or before the specified closing date of Saturday 14th January 2012 and be fully and correctly completed, or else may be rejected.
12. Entries will be restricted to ensure the meet runs to time and will be accepted on a timed order fastest being first, but with consideration to balancing out the numbers in each year age category.
13. If the event is oversubscribed the promoter reserves the right to return entries. The promoter's decision is final.
14. If poolside numbers are too high swimmers with only 1 or 2 entries may be rejected regardless of entry time.

The Events

15. The ONE START rule applies in all events.
16. OVER THE TOP starts will be used in the heats if required by the referee.
17. ALL RACES will be SPEARHEADED.
18. The age groups are: 9*/10yrs, 11/12yrs, 13/14yrs, 15+yrs.
* **9 year old swimmers before or on day of meet can not enter 100m events.**
19. Ages are as at midnight on 4th February 2012.
20. Awards will be awarded to the first 3 in each age group (above) in each event..
21. All events are Heat Declared Winners.
22. Entry fees will be £5.00 per event (this includes the ASA's 15p levy)
23. The pool length is 25m and there are 8 lanes with anti turbulence lane ropes.
24. The Depth of the water is variable from 0 to 1.8 metres across the pool. It will be set to 1.8m for the competition.

25. Session timings may change slightly, depending on the number of entries received and accepted. Any changes will be posted on the web.
26. A list of accepted entries & rejections will be posted on the web as confirmation.
27. This will be a CARDLESS meet where swimmers will be required to SIGN IN for EACH event they are swimming.

Passes & Payments

28. Coach's passes for Saturday will be £15.00 EACH (*Maximum 2 coach passes per club.*)
29. In accordance with ASA Guidelines for Child Protection, Coach Passes cannot be purchased on the day of the meet.
30. Passes can only be obtained by completing the meet summary form with named persons/coaches and submitting it to the Promoter. Passes must be displayed at all times.
31. One cheque per club would be appreciated. (*Refund cheques will only be payable to your club*)
32. No one will be allowed on poolside without a pass.

General

33. By submitting an entry form or TM entry, Clubs, Competitor's and Coach's are agreeing to be bound by these rules.
34. Any thing not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoters.
